SAMPLE PROJECTS

Campostella Road: Faith Works volunteers helped an elderly, disabled couple by rebuilding the front porch, including the roof, and replacing the front door. Inside, they installed a new kitchen faucet and rebuilt all the bathroom floors. Total cost - \$1.265.

Head River Road: A home with serious termite damage was transformed in four days. FWC removed the flooring and substructure then installed new girders, floor joists, insulation and subflooring. New carpet completed this renovation at a cost of \$1,925

Thompkins Ln: Volunteers worked with Youth Camps and other partners to restore heat, windows, decking, water. Cost \$4,500

Goldeneye Drive- Volunteers sealed the roof, added new insulation. They rebuilt the wheelchair ramp, entry steps, back door and reinforced railings. Total cost -\$550
